Photo Montage Suggestions

Montage Length

Choose 1-85 pictures for this special presentation. This will give you a montage that is about 8-10 minutes long. Going over 90 pictures will make your montage too long and is not recommended. Choosing 3-4 songs typically covers the entire time of the montage. List in order the songs you would like.

Sequence

These two options are often what work best when putting together a photo montage for your special day:

Chronological

- Order your photos starting with baby photos up to the present. This is the most popular way to arrange photos and it is very interesting too, for both you and your party guests to see friends, family, and your son or daughter change throughout the years.
- Number the back of each photograph

Segmented

- Another popular way to arrange photos is to group pictures into different categories.
For example:
 - Baby photos
 - Photos with family members
 - Pictures of your child in action if they play a sport
 - School friends
 - Camp friends
- This is totally up to you, choose whatever categories you like or that work best with your photos. To announce each new section, it is ideal to show a slide with the name of the category at the start of each.
- Once you have ordered your categories, number the back of each photograph in that category (Baby 1, 2, 3, etc) Next group (Family 1, 2, 3, 4, etc) Indicate to us the order of the groups in the montage (Baby, Family, Friends, Vacations, etc.)
